WGTE's FM 91 is the only radio station in Northwest Ohio dedicated to the arts and classical music in particular. This area enjoys a vibrant cultural presence, and FM 91 plays a leadership role in developing content that reaches many audiences.

FM 91 brought the region over 377 local productions along with its daily broadcasts of NPR news programs this year. While classical music continued to be a focal point in the morning, afternoon and evenings, the likes of longtime programs such as Jazz Spectrum with Fritz Byers and Electronic Currents with Richard Paton continued bringing different sounds and voices on the weekends.


